

BURSARY TO ATTEND

NBHPCA PALLIATIVE CARE CONFERENCE

May 4 & 5, 2023

<u>Purpose:</u> To provide financial support to attend the NBHPCA Palliative Care Conference in Moncton, New Brunswick, May 4 & 5, 2023

<u>Amount:</u> 6 bursaries of up to \$600 each are available. If the 2023 Moncton conference location is greater than 100 km from the applicants place of residence, Conference registration as well as travel expenses will be considered. Receipts will be required. If the 2023 Moncton conference location is less than 100 km from the applicants place of residence, Conference registration will be paid, travel expenses will not be paid. Receipts will be required.

Who can Apply?: Anyone currently working with the palliative care population.

Requirements: Submission to include the following:

Written report – You must submit a written report (500 words or less) explaining what palliative care means to you and the benefits to be gained from attending this conference.

Reference Letter - You must submit one reference letter as part of your application for the NBHPCA Palliative Care Conference bursary. The individual who writes your reference letter should know you well, describe your role in working with the palliative care population and indicate his/her role within the organization along with contact information.

<u>Application Submission:</u> Completed application along with written report and reference letter to be submitted to <u>Lana.hebert@horizonnb.ca</u> NO LATER than March 1, 2023.

Application deadline: The deadline is March 1, 2023.

<u>Awarding of Bursary:</u> Applications and Reference letters will be reviewed by members of the NBHPCA for the purpose of assessing submissions and determining recipients. Successful applicants will be notified no later than March 27, 2023. Bursary will be awarded to successful applicants upon receipt of "paid in full" registration to the Palliative Care Conference.
